

Paper requirements

1. Submissions should address a relevant scientific and/or practical problem within the conference scope.
2. The work must demonstrate scientific and/or practical novelty, with a clearly defined contribution of the author(s).
3. Submitted abstracts must be original and not previously published or under review elsewhere.
4. Papers must align with the conference themes and tracks.
5. Length: 5-7 full pages, formatted according to the [template](#) and requirements; 7-12 references required.

Formatting Requirements

Font: Times New Roman, line spacing 1.15, first-line indent (except headings) 1.2 cm.

Margins: top – 2.75 cm; bottom, left, right – 2 cm.

Author's full name – bold, 14 pt, right-aligned, spacing before paragraph: 12 pt.

Affiliation – 14 pt, right-aligned.

E-mail – italic, 14 pt, right-aligned.

Title – bold, 14 pt, uppercase, centered, spacing before and after: 12 pt.

Abstract – 12 pt, justified.

Keywords – 12 pt, justified.

Subheadings – bold, 14 pt, justified, spacing before: 6 pt.

Main text – 14 pt, justified.

Table text – 12 pt, left-aligned and vertically centered.

Numbered / bulleted lists: font – 14 pt; alignment – justified; left indent – 0; first-line indent – 1.2 cm. Bullet format – "•". Numbering format – "1.". Tab stop: bulleted lists – 1.75 cm; numbered lists – 2 cm.

References – font: 12 pt; numbered list, justified alignment.

Manuscripts must be submitted in .doc, .docx, or .rtf format.
